Notification on RSPO Re-certification Assessment of PT SMART Tbk, Batu Ampar Palm Oil Mill and Its Supply Base

Date: 11th August 2017

Dear Stakeholders,

PT SMART Tbk (RSPO Membership number: 1-0019-05-000-00) – a subsidiary of **Golden Agri Resources LTD** – has applied to PT SGS Indonesia to conduct RSPO P&C Re-certification assessment for one of their management Unit i.e. Batu Ampar Palm Oil Mill and its supply base which hold valid RSPO Certificate number RSPO20006, valid thru 25th November 2017.

The Re-certification assessment scope is Batu Ampar Palm Oil Mill and three (3) estates as supply bases located at Kelumpang Hilir Sub-District, Kotabaru District, Kalimantan Selatan Province, Indonesia against the requirement of the Roundtable on Sustainable Palm Oil, Principles and Criteria (RSPO P&C 2013) Indonesian National Interpretation INA-NI (2016) in conjunction with RSPO Certification System (June 2017); and the RSPO Supply Chain Certification Standards and Systems (SCCS) 2014 for Palm Oil Mill – Module E: Mass Balance in conjunction with RSPO Supply Chain Certification Standard and System (Revised June 2017).

The organization is a member of RSPO and has been taking an active role in the RSPO certification processes and planned to achieve RSPO Sustainable Palm Oil requirement for all of its production. PT SGS Indonesia has planned to conduct the assessment on **11th - 16th September 2017**.
